

## KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

IF IMMIGRATION, POLICE, OR FBI OFFICERS TRY TO ENTER YOUR HOME

### DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR

Ask the officers to identify themselves and show a “warrant” under the door that authorizes them to enter your specific home.

### OFFICERS MUST HAVE A WARRANT TO ENTER

The warrant should include the word “WARRANT” and your address. If it does not, the officers are not authorized to enter and you should not let them in.

### IF OFFICERS ENTER ANYWAY

Do not try to stop them. Tell them they do not have your permission to enter. Try to get their names or badge numbers to file a complaint later.

### IF OFFICERS HAVE A WARRANT

They may enter your home but can ONLY search for people or items listed on the warrant.

### EXERCISE YOUR RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT

You do not have to speak to an officer. You can remain silent or tell the officer you want to speak to an attorney or your consulate first. Do not answer questions about your name, age, immigration status, or any other questions. Do not present any identity documents and do not sign anything.

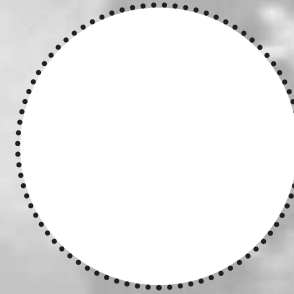
### DO NOT LIE TO OFFICERS

Do not present false documents or lie. This will only make the situation worse.

IF SOMEONE IS ARRESTED

### SAN DIEGO COUNTY JAILS
